Awards

Graduate student award: \$1000

Undergraduate student award: \$500

Criteria

Work will be judged by a three-member jury on the basis of:

- Originality and creativity of idea and its expression
- Appropriate, harmonious integration of content with choice of design and materials
- Informed typographic/image design and overall composition of the work
- Skill of production technique
- Successful articulation of concept

Eligibility and Restrictions

- Must be a CBAA student member (to join, visit www.collegebookart.org/membership.html)
- Currently enrolled undergraduate or graduate student in an accredited institution, or within one year of graduation. Submissions must be accompanied by photocopy of a dated student ID or transcript showing current or recent enrollment.
- Bookwork must have been produced while an enrolled student
- Individual's work only; no group submissions
- Selected work must be display-ready
- No blank books

Submission Requirements

- Up to 2 entries per student
- Entries must be submitted on a CD
- 3 or more images of each entry, presenting multiple, informative views
- jpgs at 300 dpi
- maximum image size of 9"×12" or 1200–1500 pixels
- Image filename must include artist's last name, title of book and # of view/image

Word document in a separate file; please include the following:

- Artist's name, mailing address, telephone number
- Title of work
- Year of completion
- Edition size (if any)
- Number of pages
- Dimensions (closed) H × W × D
- Dimensions (open) H × W × D
- Media
- Brief explanation of production techniques, concept, or any other relevant information (200 word maximum)
