



**CALL FOR ART: An Invitation to MICA DC Metro Alumni-
MICA TAKES FLIGHT
Reagan National Airport**

The Maryland Institute College of Art (MICA) Office of Alumni Relations, in collaboration with the Metro Washington Airport Authority (MWAA) invites your participation in an exhibition of alumni art.

The exhibition, *MICA Takes Flight* will feature the work of MICA alumni residing and /or working in the Washington, DC metro area. The exhibition invites small sculpture, fiber, ceramic, and 3-d illustration for the airport's Gallery Walk display cases, as well as a range of 2-d works for the corridor walls connecting Terminals A and B at Reagan National Airport. The exhibition coincides with the long-awaited November 1st launch of JetBlue from the airport. A major air carrier, JetBlue will be housed in Terminal A., in immediate proximity to Gallery Walk. Exhibition areas include public entry, elevated display cases, and corridor walls. The exhibition will be promoted throughout the airport.

Artists are invited to submit up to 4 images to review for exhibition. Work must be available for the four month exhibition period of October 28, 2010-February 28, 2011, and suitable for display in a public setting. All DC Metro area MICA alums are eligible to submit work for consideration. Artists are also encouraged to visit the site.

About the site:

The Gallery Walk is located within an interior ground-level public passageway in the original National Airport Terminal. Exhibitions planned for the Gallery Walk rotate every four months-three times a year. The gallery space consists of five fixed glass-enclosed display cases for displaying three-dimensional artwork and approximately two hundred and sixty linear feet of flanking wall space for displaying two-dimensional artwork. Gallery cases contain display platforms and lighting and are secured with locks. Gallery walls are outfitted with hanging rails and track lighting. Artwork hung on gallery walls is monitored within the security plan for the passageway.
