TRADE NAME: Desiccated Liver

SYNONYMS: Whole Dried Liver, Liver

HAZARDOUS INGREDIENTS: None

DESCRIPTION: Desiccated Liver is the product formed by minced whole liver obtained from animals for food by man.

Percent VOLATILES: Not more than 6 percent

APPEARANCE AND ODOR: Dark brown powder of various mesh sizes having a typical liver odor.

SOLUBILITY IN WATER: 90 percent

FIRE HAZARD: None but extreme dispersion of fine powder must be avoided as for any organic powder.

FIRE EXTINGUISHING MEDIA: Water

HEALTH HAZARD: None, product is suitable as a food or food additive -- avoid inhalation of dust and prevent eye contact under extreme dusting of product.

EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES: In the rare event of eye contamination, water may be used for irrigation.

NOTES TO PHYSICIAN: Rarely causes upset due to sensitivity to animal products.
